Saturday from 10 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. through Oct. 11. The market is located on the Ivoryton Green, next to the iconic Ivoryton Playhouse (the Chester Sunday Market is also underway-see "Sunday Market Returns for the Summer Season" on page 7).

Dave Sousa, one of the local farmers who has a display at the market, said, "We really just want people to think about supporting local farmers, shopping local, buying local. It's all about that theme."

Sousa said the market has about 16 vendors "and the turnout has been very good, especially when you consider that we've been competing with events such as graduations and jazz festivals and the like."


The market is sponsored by the Ivoryton Village Alliance to support Connecticut farms and small businesses and to provide a new venue for the residents of Ivoryton and surrounding towns to purchase fresh, locally grown produce and locally made products.

Connecticut-grown local produce, garlic, baked goods, fresh eggs, local beef and pork, fresh herbs, honey, syrup, coffee, flavored oils, prepared food, Italian ice, and dog and cat treats will be for sale.

Weekly, there will also be local crafters and live music.
